Military Escort: Leaves Petro at 2:30 PM to Jessup Hose Company No.2

Setup: Upon arrival to the Grounds (min 12 volunteers needed)

Display: The memorial will be on 24 hour display from Thursday, September 7 at 4:00 PM until Sunday, September 10 at 5:00 PM.

Korean War Memorial Ceremony: Saturday, September 9 at 11:00AM

If you are a Korean War Veteran, or family member of our local fallen, please arrive no later than 10:45am. Our ceremony will include full military honors for the 71 KIA/MIA Korean War Veterans from Lackawanna County, recognition of those Korean War Veterans who attend, and special Guest Tom Reimensyder, USMC. Tom's image is the subject for one of the 38 statues that comprise the Memorial.
